1st Annual LEGO ARTISTS CHALLENGE
Rules and Guidelines

Saturday November 22nd 9:00am – Varies, See Below

1. Use your own LEGO, Duplo, Megablocks or other LEGO compatible plastic brick.
2. Entries may be original creations or creations from a Lego kit, however please note that creations from kits will NOT be eligible for prizes.
3. One entry per person or team where applicable.
4. Your creation must fit within a space of 24 by 24 inches. Your completed project must be no taller than four feet tall.
5. Team projects will be placed in the category of the oldest participant in the team. Individual entries will not be permitted for team participants. Please note that while all members of a team will receive a certificate for participation a team will compete for a single prize.
6. Include a sign that explains the idea/inspiration for your creation to help the judges make their determinations.
7. Please provide a sign/label with your project with your name(s), school, grade, project name, and phone #.
8. Completed projects must be delivered to the Danbury Plaza in the Waterbury Room between 9:00 and 9:45AM
9. Judging will be conducted Saturday November 22, 2008 between 11AM and 12:00 Noon by a team of adult LEGO enthusiasts.
10. If your creation is a winner – you will be notified via phone after judging. (Number supplied by you upon drop off). The awards ceremony will be at 4:00. Prizes will be given out at that time and a photo will be taken of the winners. At that point, you may take your creation with you or leave it for display on Sunday as well. Pick up Sunday is between 4:00 and 5:00 pm.
11. If your creation is not a winner – you will not receive a phone call. You are welcome to either pick up your piece Saturday between 4:30 and 5:00pm or leave your piece on display until the Festival ends Sun (Pick up 4-5pm)

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded in each grade category for best overall projects. We will be looking for overall creativity and best use of LEGO product. Some things that you might want to consider while building are; use of color, original concept for piece that is built, and/or integrated moving parts

Every entrant will receive a certificate of participation.
