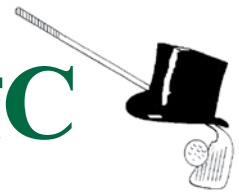

We are pleased to announce that the 2007 Ann Olsen Greater Danbury Golf Classic will be held on Monday, September 10th at the Ridgewood Country Club in Danbury. Proceeds from The Classic go directly to Ann's Place, The Home of I CAN to maintain current services for area cancer patients and their families. Our community cancer support agency, offering free and confidential services, is the most comprehensive facility of its kind in this region. Our well-recognized program provides group support, counseling, financial aid, wellness programs for men, women, couples, teens and children. Demand for services continues to be strong with monthly patient loads averaging 625. Golf Classic participation since our first outing in 1987 has been indispensable to our ability to offer these resources.

Based on your positive feedback to last year's tournament format, we are again delaying the shotgun start so that you can attend to early Monday business, register at 10:30 a.m., compete in the Putting Contest and enjoy lunch beginning at 11 a.m.

We will keep play brisk by limiting the entries to 34 teams. Last year's streamlined afternoon activities and awards program were a direct result of your desire to keep a comfortable but brisk pace while enjoying the day. We aim to keep that formula. Post-play contests will again be moderated while scoring is in progress to keep activities moving. Raffle winners will be posted by the cocktail hour, so it's important to get your tickets early in the day. This year, we will offer course contests with a new twist that include a \$1,000 Calloway Gift Card payoff on one hole and a rare chance to Beat the Pro on another.

Construction on our new facility on Sawmill Road is underway, so raising operating funds has never been more important to Ann's Place, as programs expand to meet demand. Every tee sign and program ad sold mean that another cancer patient will be able to get another hour of individualized attention.
